RE: APPLICATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION FOR THE REFURBISHMENT AND UPGRADE OF THE DIPHITSHI CLUSTER WATER MINI SCHEME WITHIN THE MOGALAKWENA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY OF WATERBERG DISTRICT

The Department hereby acknowledges receipt of the application and a Basic Assessment Report (BAR) for consultation for the above-mentioned proposed development received on 11 July 2018.

1. The application is allocated with Departmental reference number: 12/1/9/1-W164 and NEAS reference number: LIM/EIA/0000627/2018. Kindly quote these numbers in all future correspondence regarding this application.
2. The property information (deed searches) are not attached to the application form as indicated in B. SITE IDENTIFICATION AND LINKAGE. The Locality map attached in the BAR contains "21 digit Surveyor-general (SG) site reference numbers" but with additional digits. The farm Raadslid 718 LR, for example, is TOLR000000071800000 according to available records. Kindly confirm.
3. The geographical coordinates provided, 23° 43' 30.08" South and 28° 42' 34.5" East in the application form couldn't represent the site/s described in the activities included to require authorisation, as it is nowhere near a river or stream. In the absence of an indication of the proposed position of the storage tank (reservoir), it is not possible to confirm if Activity 2 (or 16) of Listing Notice 3 of the amended Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of 2014 is applicable to the proposed project or not.
4. It is required that for the application for the expansion/upgrade of an existing activity, the status in terms of environmental legislation of the existing development/infrastructure be indicated and verified. The feasibility of a maintenance management plan in order to address requirements with regards to the sand pit abstraction well in the Mogalakwena River should be considered.
5. The project description provided doesn't include adequate information to rule out whether Activities 14 or 23 of Listing Notice 3 of the EIA Regulations of 2014, as amended, will be applicable or not.
